General Information

- **Food:** Coffee and donuts will be available in the AM and water throughout the day. Please bring your own lunch. There is a WaWa, Chinese restaurant, Pizzeria to the right and Burger King, McDonald's, and Pizzeria etc. to the left.
- **Move-ups for Trial 1** will be allowed through **November 6th** (no exceptions). All move-up requests must be sent via email by the deadline to the trial secretary. Move-ups will be allowed between trials 1 & 2 both in Level and in Class.
- **Entries** accepted on a first-come-first served basis. Initial confirmations will be sent out as they are processed. All final confirmations and final judging program will be sent by e-mail.
- **Crating:** There is plenty of room in the designated crating area. **The K9 JYM no longer allows X-pens in the crating areas without pads and a protective covering under them.**
- These trials will be held indoors on ¾" rubber mat flooring.
- The building is heated and air-conditioned but please dress according to weather. Running water is available.

Please note: If you are entering Level 2 or 3, please indicate the actual jump height on the entry form. This will allow us to arrange run order according to jump height and will make the day run more smoothly.

Awards

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog/owner team who achieves a score of 170 or better. Placement rosettes will be awarded to the top 5 high scoring teams in both A & B classes. New Level title, New Level Champion Title & Championship rosettes will be awarded to all teams completing titles.

Special awards will be given in each trial: High Scoring Veteran, High Scoring Therapy Dog, High Scoring Rescue Dog and the Rally Spirit Team Award in memory of Temar's Black Thunderbolt. We will also be having our usual NQ & Poop Raffle. **And back by popular demand will be Luis Santiago, Jr. / Foggytop photography!**

Directions to Trial Site

From North: Route 78 East to Route 309 South, Go through Quakertown, pass Souderton, you will come to a traffic light with a large shopping center on Left side (Wal-Mart, McDonalds) and a strip mall on right side, next light Zoto’s diner on right, next light Burger King on Left, 3rd light is a car wash on right side 1st driveway on right (into small strip mall) after carwash. You will also see a sign for Dogtown. Go around back.

From PA Turnpike Willow Grove Exit. Go right to 611 North/Easton Rd. Turn left on Horsham Rd//Route 463 (past where Oakes K9 training center is), follow past left side Hatboro Horsham High School, left side Horsham Police Station, right side Montgomeryville Police Station, right side Home Depot, you come to a five point intersection, make a slight right onto 309 North, (Left side Yum Yum Donuts) cross railroad tracks, pass WAWA right side, turn left into small strip mall (sign there for Dogtown) follow behind building.

Rally Class Description

You must be familiar with all the Rally exercise signs, as well as the Rally Rules and Guidelines prior to the event. Go to www.rallydogs.com for an explanation of each of the exercise signs and have fun practicing them with your dog.

Veteran Class Eligibility Based on Age and Weight (Effective July 1, 2017)

Veteran class is open to all dogs who meet the age and weight eligibility as set forth in the following table:

Dog’s Weight	Dog’s Minimum Age for Veteran Class
90 pounds or more	6 years
50 pounds and less than 90 pounds	7 years
Under 50 pounds	8 years

A Veteran Level course will consist of 12 exercises from any Level, plus Start, Finish and a Bonus Exercise from any Level. Please see the Rally Rules and Guidelines on Level Veteran for more details.

A and B Classes

“A” classes are for teams that have NOT yet completed their title at that level.

“B” classes are for teams that have already completed their title at that level.



Jump Heights (*Effective July 1, 2017*)

Dogs are not required to be measured the day of the trial or prior to judging. However, judges have the option to measure any dog prior to his/her performance if the dog appears to be entered in a group lower than might be indicated by his/her registered shoulder height. Jump heights may also be modified or the jump exercise excused entirely based on physical challenges (e.g. age, disability such as blindness, or use of a mobility device) that a particular dog may face.

The following table shows the recommended and minimum allowable jump heights based upon the dog's height at the withers. The selected jump height shall be indicated on the Entry Form. The "minimum allowable jump height" for each height category is the minimum height permitted without a Request for Modification being made. A handler may select a higher height at their sole discretion, but must have designated the height on the entry form.

Height at Withers	Minimum Allowable Jump Height	Recommended Jump Height
12" or less	4"	4"
16" or less	4"	8"
20" or less	8"	12"
Over 20"	12"	16"

Puppy Level Note

- Puppy Level (along with RLP and RLPX titles) will be continued until December 31, 2017, after which it will be discontinued and replaced by Intro class.
- If an RLP is not earned by end of 2017, any Qs earned toward the RLP will be converted to Intro Qs in 2018.

Intro Class Option (*Effective July 1, 2017*)

- Intro class may be offered, at host's discretion, on the same course as Puppy Level. (Puppy Level will be discontinued starting January 1, 2018. See Puppy Level Note above.)
- Intro class is open to dogs 6 months or older, but dogs who have earned the RL1 or higher are not eligible for placement awards, if offered, in this class.
- There is no separation of Intro class into A and B classes.
- Titles: Any legs earned in Intro class in 2017 will be recorded, but Intro titles will not be issued until 2018.

Notice to Competitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of WCRL rules and regulations (see www.rallydogs.com), including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- This trial is open to a dog at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries, or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
- All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar, plain harness, or properly fitted Martingale (limited slip) collar. No choke collar, prong collars, shock collars, no-pull harnesses, Martingale leads, or head collars are allowed.
- All dogs must be registered with World Cynosport Rally Limited (or previously APDT Rally) or United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. on the day of competition. We regret we cannot accept an entry without a valid WCRL/USDAA registration number. See www.rallydogs.com to register online, or complete the “Dog and Junior Handler Registration” form included in this premium list and submit it to the WCRL office as indicated at the bottom of the form.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
- THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. A dog or handler who suffers an injury and/or illness or bitches that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a 50% refund of their total entry fee. Written request for refund must be made to the Trial Secretary BEFORE the end of the event, **November 11, 2017**. Please provide documentation from your veterinarian/physician. There will be no refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a **\$35.00** service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- All competitors through entry at this event grant to World Cynosport Rally Limited, their representatives, agents, and assigns, all rights and permissions to use or appropriate my and the dog’s name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia or identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission, or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known and waive any and all rights relative thereto.
- All competitors through entry at this event grant to World Cynosport Rally Limited, their representatives, agents, and assigns, hereby release WCRL, the hosting club, their representatives, agents, and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of personality, or any similar right.
- Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes without the express written consent of World Cynosport Rally Limited.
- Upon successful completion of a Stationary exercise, the owner may choose to briefly pet or touch the dog as a reward. The owner may also choose to give the dog food as a reward. Food may NOT be used as a lure to help the dog complete an exercise. Food rewards must be contained in pockets and only be present in the owner’s hand at the completion of any Stationary exercise. Any petting, touching, or feeding that significantly interrupts the flow of performance shall be scored accordingly. Veteran and Puppy classes allow food rewards to be used more liberally.
- Dogs must remain under control at all times whether on or off leash while on trial site grounds. Day kenneling only is permitted.
- Please pick up after your dog and yourself.
